



**MAT to continue as an entrance test to PGDM institutes across India as per Supreme Court of India on 18th February 2013.**

## 1 About MAT

**Management Aptitude Test (MAT)** is a standardised test being administered since 1988 to facilitate Business Schools (B-Schools) to screen candidates for admission to MBA and allied programmes. Govt. of India, Ministry of HRD approved MAT as a national level test in 2003. Any B-School - national or international - can consider MAT Score as an admission input based on the Score Cards issued to the candidates. The largest test of its kind in the nation, MAT will continue to be your passport to over 600 B-Schools across India.

DD is also to be sent along with the Printout of the Registration Form, if payment was made through DD.)</p>
<p><b>Test Centre City</b> (Will be available from 1st week of July onwards)</p>	<p>Test Centre City list is provided in the dropdown menu for the test centre choices in the registration form. Test Venues for Paper-Based Test and Computer Based Test are different. The Paper-Based Test will take place only on one day i.e., 03 September 2017 at one time slot i.e., 10.00am-12.30 pm, whereas the Computer Based Test will take place from 09 September 2017 in different time slots. If the number of candidates registered for Computer Based Test is limited and it can be accommodated in a single day; the test will be completed on 09 September 2017 itself.</p>
<p><b>MAT Registration Form Acknowledgement</b></p>	<p>All filled-in forms or printout of online registration if required to be sent; received at AIMA will be processed within 5 days and the Form Numbers of such received forms will be available on website link: <b><a href="http://apps.aima.in/mat_reciept.aspx">http://apps.aima.in/mat_reciept.aspx</a></b> Such receipts will be scrutinized and if found in order; it will be provisionally registered. However, form printout received later than the due date is liable to be rejected. Neither any correspondence in this regard will be entertained nor the fee to be refunded.</p>
<p><b>Admit Card</b></p>	<p>All provisionally registered candidates both for Paper Based and Computer Based Test can download their Admit Card from AIMA website link: (<b><a href="http://apps.aima.in/matadmitcard.aspx">http://apps.aima.in/matadmitcard.aspx</a></b>) on or after 26 August 2017 (Saturday). Specific Admit Card is generated both for the candidates opted for the Paper Based Test and for the Computer Based Test. Admit Card contains Candidate's Name, Form No, Roll No, Test Date, Test Time and Test Venue Address. Candidate has to strictly follow the date and time allotted to him/her in the case of Computer Based Test.</p>
