### Global meeting end without agreement on treaty to combat plastic pollution

A global meeting in South Korea's Busan to finalise a treaty to combat plastic pollution concluded without an agreement. This was the fifth meeting of the Intergovernmental Negotiating Committee, which has been working since 2022 to draft a legally binding treaty on plastic pollution.

### Centre-left party wins Iceland's election

Iceland's centre-left Social Democratic Alliance has won the most votes in snap elections prompted by the collapse of the coalition in power for the past seven years. The Social Democrats won 15 seats in the 63-seat parliament, the Althingi, with 20.8 percent of the votes.

# Voting underway in Romania to elect new Parliament Voting is underway in Romania to elect the new

Parliament. More than 18 million Romanian citizens, including those living abroad are casting ballots to fill 332 seats in the Chamber of Deputies and 137 in the Senate.

### South Korean President lifts emergency martial law

South Korean President Yoon Suk Yeol has announced the lifting of emergency martial law after the National Assembly voted to end it, following fierce opposition from lawmakers across the political spectrum.

### French government collapses in no-confidence vote

The French government has collapsed after Prime Minister Michel Barnier was ousted in a no-confidence vote. MPs voted overwhelmingly in support of the motion against him just three months after he was appointed by President.

### US announces new 725 million dollars military aid package for Ukraine

The United States has announced a new 725 million dollars military aid package for Ukraine that features a second tranche of landmines as well as anti-air and antiarmour weapons.

### India to Chair UN Commission on Narcotic Drugs for the first time

India has been chosen to Chair the 68th Session of the Commission on Narcotic Drugs (CND). India's Permanent Representative to the UN in Vienna, Shambhu Kumaran officially assumed the Chairmanship of CND. This is the first time that India has been named to Chair this important UN body.

### UK joins US and Bahrain in C-SIPA

The United States, Bahrain, and the United Kingdom have announced an expansion of their strategic partnership through the Comprehensive Security Integration and Prosperity Agreement (C-SIPA). C-SIPA was initially established between the US and Bahrain in 2023.

### Burkina Faso's military dissolves the government

Burkina Faso's military junta issued a decree dismissing Prime Minister Apollinaire Joachim Kyelem de Tambela and announced the dissolution of the national government.

### Ghana presidential elections

In Ghana's presidential elections, opposition candidate John Mahama claimed victory in elections after ruling New Patriotic Party candidate and Vice President Mahamudu Bawumia conceded defeat before even announcement of official results.

### Romania, Bulgaria to join EU's Schengen area

Romania and Bulgaria are set to fully join the European Union border-free Schengen Area on January 1, 2025. The border-free Schengen Area quarantees free movement to more than 425 million European Union citizens, along with non-EU nationals living in the EU or visiting the EU.

### India backs UNGA resolution for immediate ceasefire in Gaza Strip

India has joined 157 other nations in supporting a United Nations General Assembly (UNGA) resolution demanding an 'immediate, unconditional, and permanent ceasefire in the war-torn Gaza Strip.

### Britain becomes the first European nation to join the CPTPP.

Britain became the first European nation to join the Comprehensive and Progressive Agreement for Trans-Pacific Partnership (CPTPP), becoming the 12th member of the bloc.

### The Embassy of Moldova inaugurated in New Delhi.

External Affairs Minister Dr. S. Jaishankar and Deputy Prime Minister of Moldova, Mihail Popsoi, jointly inaugurated the Embassy of Moldova in New Delhi. Moldova also signed the International Solar Alliance (ISA) Framework Agreement and officially joined the ISA.

### India, France, UAE strengthen defence ties with Desert Knight air combat exercise

India, France, and the UAE have began a major air combat exercise, "Desert Knight," over the Arabian Sea. The operation aims to enhance trilateral defence cooperation and foster better interoperability among their air forces during complex combat scenarios.

### Sri Lanka to offer visa-free travel to Indian nationals from Jan 2025

Indians will be among the nationals from 39 countries, who will have free visas to travel to Sri Lanka from January 2025. Sri Lanka will give free visas to 39 countries, including India.

### 7.3 magnitude earthquake hits Vanuatu, 14 dead

A powerful 7.3 magnitude earthquake struck the island nation of Vanuatu, with its epicentre located near the capital, Port Vila. The earthquake has claimed at least 14 lives, with the death toll expected to rise.

### Sweden to expand defence capabilities by 2030

Sweden's Parliament has approved a new defence plan, increasing the military budget from 125 billion Swedish Krona (SEK) in 2024 to 186 billion SEK by 2030.

### Cyclone Chido Death Toll Rises to 45 in Mozambique

The death toll from Cyclone Chido in Mozambique has risen to 45. In Malawi, the death toll from the remnants of Tropical Cyclone Chido has risen to 13 while more than 45,000 people are affected by heavy rains.

### Russia-Ukraine rule out renewing key gas transit deal for Europe

Russia and Ukraine have both ruled out renewing a key gas transit deal for Europe. Russian President Vladimir Putin stated that Kyiv has refused to extend the five-year agreement to transport Russian gas across Ukraine beyond its expiry at the end of this month.

Over 78% of top paid H1B applicants were from India In the last four years, more than 78% of the top paid H-1B applicants (whose proposed wage rate exceeded \$1 million per year) were from India. Among the Indians whose wage rate exceeded \$1 million per year, over 25% were women.

### US House passes bill to fund government

The US House of Representatives passed a spending bill narrowly avoiding a consequential government shutdown just few hours before the deadline came to end. The Democrats joined Republican lawmakers to advance the bill to keep the federal government funded until mid-March next year.

# India dispatches 1,000 MT of humanitarian aid to Lesotho

India has extended humanitarian assistance to Lesotho, a country in Southern Africa. A consignment of one thousand metric tonnes has departed from Nhava Sheva Port for Lesotho.

France begins withdrawal of military forces from Chad France has commenced the withdrawal of its military forces from Chad, following the Central African nation's decision to end its defence cooperation agreement with France.

### India, Kuwait sign several bilateral agreements

India and Kuwait signed four MoUs in the areas of defence, sports and cultural cooperation during Prime Minister Narendra Modi's visit to the Gulf nation.

# Bangladesh seeks extradition of ousted PM Sheikh Hasina from India

Bangladesh has submitted a formal request to India to extradite its former prime minister Sheikh Hasina, who fled to New Delhi in August amid student-led protests that ended her 15 years in power.

### UNICEF reports 14,500 children killed in Gaza

The United Nations Relief and Works Agency for Palestine Refugees in the Near East (UNRWA) has stated that one child is killed every hour in the Gaza Strip. Since the start of the conflict, 14 thousand 500 children have been reported killed in Gaza, as per UNICEF's data.

### German President Dissolves the Country's Lower House

Following the collapse of Chancellor Olaf Scholz's threeway coalition, German President Frank-Walter Steinmeier dissolved the country's lower house of parliament to pave the way for snap elections on 23rd February.

# South Korea's National Assembly to Impeach Acting President Han Duck-soo

Less than two weeks after he took over for President Yoon Suk Yeol, who was impeached for his botched imposition of martial law, South Korea's National Assembly voted to impeach acting President Han Duck-soo.

### Russia declares federal emergency over Black Sea oil spill

Russia warned of severe environmental damage from a huge oil spill in the Black Sea caused when two tankers collided in a storm near Crimea, which declared a state of emergency.



### Centre asks states and UTs to make snakebite cases a Notifiable Disease

The Union Health Ministry has asked states and Union Territories to make snakebite cases and deaths a 'Notifiable Disease' under the relevant provisions of the State Public Health Act or other applicable legislation.

# Indian Army, Singapore armed forces conclude joint military exercise "Agni Warrior 2024"

The Joint Military Exercise Agni Warrior 2024 between Indian Armed Forces and Singapore Armed Forces concluded in Devlali, Maharashtra. The aim of the exercise was to maximise mutual understanding of drills and procedures to achieve jointness as a multinational force under the United Nations Charter.

# Defence Ministry signs contract with Cochin Shipyard The Defence Ministry signed a contract with Cochin Shipyard Limited for the short refit and dry docking of INS Vikramaditya at an overall cost of more than 1,200 crore rupees. INS Vikramaditya is an Indian aircraft carrier commissioned in the Indian Navy in November 2013.

# India-Cambodia armies commence Joint Exercise CINBAX Begins in Pune

The Indian Army and the Cambodian Army have commenced their first-ever Joint Table Top Exercise, CINBAX, in Pune. The exercise aims to foster strategic cooperation, trust, and interoperability between the two nations.

India's External Affairs Minister Dr S Jaishankar has released Vikram Sampath's book titled "Tipu Sultan-The Saga of the Mysore Interregnum" in New Delhi.

The Centre will soon bring out a national policy document on female labour force participation with a focus on providing an enabling atmosphere like a viable care economy structure.

# Centre launches 16 initiatives to empower Divyangjans

On the occasion of the International Day of Persons with Disabilities 2024 on December 3, the Centre launched sixteen initiatives in New Delhi to empower Divyangjans across the nation.
